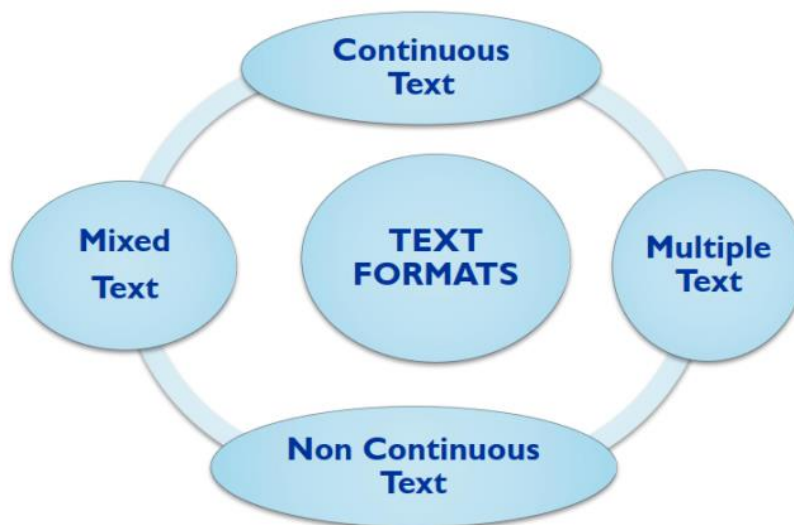

- **несплошные тексты** (таблицы, графики, диаграммы, списки, карты, объявления...);
- **смешанные тексты** (сплошные + несплошные тексты);
- **составные тексты** (несколько текстов)

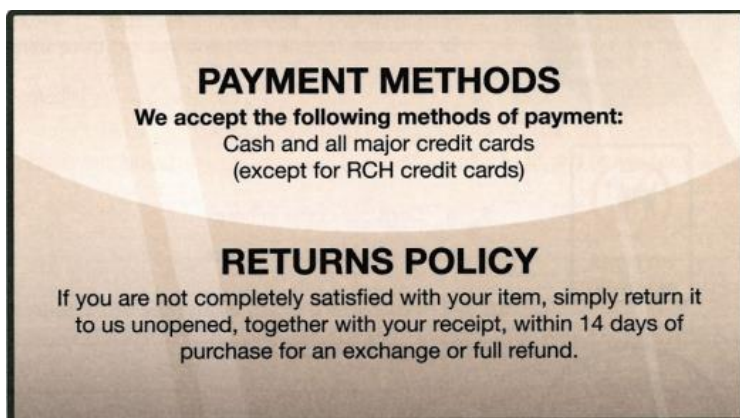

Fast, effective relief from:

- fever (high temperature)
- cold and flu symptoms
- toothache
- headache
- earache
- sore throat

Dosage:

Child's age	How much?
6-8 years	One 5ml spoonful
8-12 years	Two 5ml spoonfuls
12-16 years	Two to three 5ml spoonfuls

Do not give more than four doses in 24 hours.
Leave at least four hours between doses.
Do not give more than the recommended dose.
Each 5ml spoonful contains 250mg of paracetamol.

Possible side effects:
Side effects are very unlikely, but some children may experience:

- minor skin rashes
- mild stomach upsets

Do NOT give this to your child if they are:

- less than 6 years old
- allergic to ibuprofen or aspirin

If symptoms continue for longer than three days, see your doctor.
If your child is taking any other medicine, see your doctor or pharmacist before using this product.
Keep out of the reach and sight of children. Check that the lid of the bottle is closed at all times.
Do not store above 25°C.

Contains paracetamol
Do not give this medicine with any other paracetamol-containing products.
Seek immediate medical attention in the event of an overdose.

2. It's 4pm. He can have one dose now and another at 8pm.
3. Then I can give him doses every four hours, which means medicine at 12am, 4am, 8am, 12pm and 4pm over the next 24 hours.
4. My son might get a rash or a stomach upset after taking the medicine.
5. If he still has earache tomorrow, I should take him to the doctor.
6. My daughter is two years old. If she has earache, I can give her this medicine.

- remove laptops from cases and place them in a separate tray.

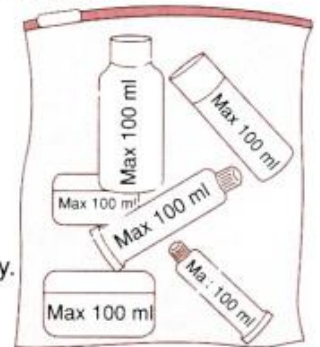
Any prohibited items will be taken by security.

- Walk through the metal detector. You may also be scanned by a handheld metal detector.
- Collect your items from the security officers.

Please note the following information about liquids:

- All liquids, gels or pastes must be held in individual containers not exceeding 100ml.
- The containers must be carried in a separate, clear-plastic, zip-top or re-sealable bag, which must not be more than 20 x 20cm with a 1 litre capacity.
- Note that these restrictions may not apply to baby food and medicines.
